- 1. Human Resources: The following staff have been hired: Angela Skrabec has been hired to cover for Lauren Kirshner's maternity leave. Jane Want has been hired this year to serve as our building sub. We are still waiting to hire our Library paraprofessional and seeking candidates for our Psychologist, Jen Wilbur who will be going out on maternity leave in November.
- 2. Teaching and Learning: Students have begun using ST Math both in the Library Media Center and in classrooms. Our biggest challenge continues to be the need for more devices in all grades. We will be launching the Personally Owned Devices (BYOD) pilot again this year at the end of October. There will be 6 teachers participating this year, two grade 3 teachers and four grade 4 teachers.
